



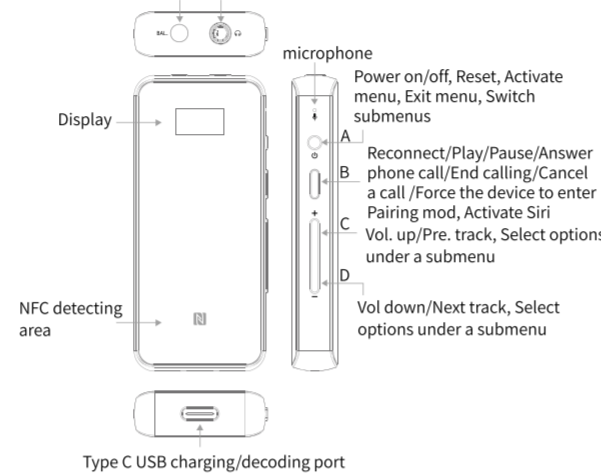

Buttons and Ports labeled/Operation explained

2.5mm headphone port 3.5mm headphone port



Functions & Operations

Power on: Hold the button A for about 3 seconds while the device is off.

Power off: Hold the button A for about 5 seconds while the device is on.

Reset: Hold the button A for about 10 seconds.

Turn off/on the display: While the device is powered on and not in Menu page, press the button A.

Activate menu: While the device is powered on and not in Menu page, hold the button A for about 2 seconds.

Exit menu: Hold the button A for about 2 seconds in the menu page.

Switch submenus: Click the button A in the menu page.

Select options under a submenu: Click the button C/D in the menu page.

Enter pairing mode: (while not in Menu page)

1. After powered on for the first time: the device would

automatically enter the pairing mode, and the display shows 'pairing'

2. Force the device to enter Pairing mode: Hold the button B for about 5 seconds when the device is on, and the display shows 'pairing'

Operation instructions after a successful pairing (while not in Menu page)

Activate Siri: Double click the button B.

Play/Pause/Answer phone call/End calling/Cancel a call: Click button B

Reject phone call: Hold the button B for about 2 seconds when there's an incoming call.

Volume up/down: Click the button C/D turn up/down the volume.

Switch songs: Hold the button C/D about 2 seconds to switch to the previous/next song.

Clear current pairing: Hold the button B and C at the same time for about 5 seconds when the device is on.

How to use the BTR5 with two Bluetooth devices simultaneously: after a successful pairing with device1, hold the button B for around 5 seconds to enter pairing mode. Search for BTR5 on the device 2 and pair it with the BTR5. On device 1, select BTR5 in the device list and reconnect. You could also restart the BTR5 after a successful pairing with device2 in order to use the BTR5 with two Bluetooth devices simultaneously.

Note: The BTR5 supports connecting with two devices at the same time.

Enter reconnecting mode (while not in Menu page)

1. After disconnection, the display shows 'RECONNECT'; click the button B to reconnect.

2. After the device restarted, it will reconnect to the last connected device automatically.

One-touch NFC pairing:

When the BTR5 is on and the Android device is unlocked with NFC enabled, get the two devices touched by the NFC detecting area to start the pairing.

Note:

When pairing to device via Bluetooth and using USB DAC function at the same time, Bluetooth connection takes priority. Please pause the Bluetooth playback when using USB DAC function.

The BTR5 volume series controls level is 32 when pairing to device via Bluetooth and 60 when using USB DAC function.

The BTR5 supports the headphones with TRRS connectors conforming to the Apple standard (CTIA).

Connect to the computer and enjoy music

When using USB Audio 2.0 mode, for Windows system computers, please go to FiiO official website to download and install USB driver. (For the MAC computer, there is no need to install the driver, but it requires to select BTR5 as the default audio output device). FiiO Support website: <https://www.fii.com/supports>

When using USB Audio 1.0 mode, no driver installation is required. Just select the BTR5 as the default audio output device after connecting to the computer. It is recommended to adjust the volume of the computer to max level, and control the output volume on the BTR5.

Note:

You'll need to re-plug the BTR5 after switching the USB Audio 1.0/2.0 mode.

Notes and Precautions

★It's recommended to charge the device using a standard 5V charger.

★Please don't place the device in circumstance of excessive high/low temperature (above 45°C or below 0°C)

★Please keep the device away from liquids to avoid any damage to it.

★If the device is to be left unused for a long time, please recharge it periodically to preserve its battery life.

★Please adjust the volume to a suitable level before putting on the earphones to protect your hearing.

★Please do not disassemble, damage the battery, or drop it into fire; it's prohibited to continue using after the battery is soaked in water.

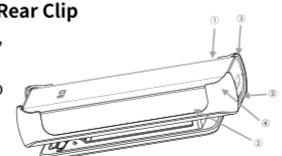

Appendix: How to Remove the Rear Clip

Hold the BTR5 with your left hand, keep its top end touching the middle of your left palm, and also keep your left index finger and thumb on the BTR5 at position ①② (as shown in the image).

Then use your right thumb and index finger to hold the clip at

position ③④, and slowly pull the clip away from the BTR5. After a gap appears between the BTR5 and the clip at position ⑤, use your right index finger to pull the clip off by position ⑤.
